The minutes of July 15, 2014 were approved as read on motion of Stauter, seconded by Beneke. Ayes all, motion carried.

The tentative agenda was approved as presented on motion of Beneke, seconded by Ives. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Stauter, seconded by Ives to authorize the chairman to sign the agreement with Bolton & Menk, Inc of Spencer for small drainage district projects such as printing of drainage district maps, evaluation and response to the river bridge, etc and saving of the administrative expenses . Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Beneke, seconded by Stauter to approve the negotiated loan payment to MIDAS in the amount of \$84,425.00 principal, \$1,000.00 interest, and \$500.00 administrative fee for a total of \$86,425.00; and direct the Housing Corp to proceed with the disposal of the house. Ayes: Stauter, Beneke; abstaining vote – Ives as a member of the MIDAS board. Motion carried.

It was moved by Ives, seconded by Beneke to acknowledge receipt of the following Manure Management Plans: (1) Lenz Poultry, Inc. facility ID# 58877, located in the SE SW, Section 4, Bellville Township with Phiip E. Lenz as the owner and contact person; (2) Randy & Kristin Plantz #1 facility ID # 61120 located in the NENE, Section 18 Grant Township with Randy Plantz as owner and contact person. Ayes all, motion carried.

Orene Cressler, VA Director and General Relief Asst. advised the board she had great concerns regarding the job description provided by Bob Lincoln, CSS Director. She has prepared a job description for an administrative deputy to serve for Veteran Affairs and General Relief at the direction of the Veteran's Affairs Commissioners and appointing herself as the director of general relief. She advised the assistants position would be 16-20 hours per week and provided various scenarios of cost. She advised she wants to make certain that the county has two people meeting the needs of the county general assistance that she felt would not be the case if the CSS region is responsible. This person would also attend all state veterans trainings to assist her in that dept as well. Lisa Peterson, Service Coordinator for Pocahontas County acknowledged that Bob Lincoln indicated in his presentation the prior week that there will be a local person to be hired to serve over this county office as he felt that was essential for the county and for the region to have a strong local workforce in the Community Services Office.

Jack Moellering, County Engineer advised the bridge lettings awarded had not moved forward in receipt of the contracts. It was moved by Stauter, seconded by Ives to table action on the contracts. Ayes all, motion carried.

Moellering advised he wanted to advise the board there will be a staffing change in that Walter Davis Oeth, Asst Engineer has accepted an engineering job with Emmet County. Walter presented his letter of resignation and expressed appreciation for the years he has had with Pocahontas County. It was moved by Stauter, seconded by Ives to accept the resignation of Walter with his last date of work to be July 31st with vacation hours of 76.75 to be taken with his employment ending August 15, 2014. The board thanked Walter for the years of service he has provided for Pocahontas County. Ayes all, motion carried.

Supervisor Stauter advised the board he had toured some areas on JT. D.D. 181 with Gary Atherton as he is working on the FEMA projects. The heavy rains of June did a great deal of damage to those repaired areas and there are other areas as well that will need attention.
