Thanks to your support in the past years, the Brushy Creek Area Honor Flight took some 500+ World War II Veterans to Washington D.C. to visit their memorials. We had 5 successful Honor flights and we need your help again.

The Brushy Creek Area Honor Flight committee has made the decision to honor Korean War Veterans and any World War II Veteran who did not have an opportunity to go on a flight yet. To be eligible, Korean War veterans must have at least one day of active duty between June 1, 1950 and January 31, 1955. Veterans determined eligible to go on our Brushy Creek Area Honor Flight must be accompanied by a guardian. All guardians must pay their own expenses and all veterans will participate at no cost to them. These veterans have paid their dues already.

Participating Honor Flight Veterans will leave Fort Dodge Regional Airport on a date to be announced and fly to Dulles Airport in Virginia and be transported to Washington D.C. to visit their memorials. These memorials will include the WWII, Korean War, Vietnam War, and Lincoln Memorials. Following a visit to the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier to witness the changing of the guard, the veterans will be transported to the Iwo Jima Memorial. The veterans will then leave Dulles Airport to arrive back home in Fort Dodge, Iowa later that evening.

The Brushy Creek Area Honor Flight is a 501C3 corporation designed to honor our "quiet heroes"...those who fought to protect our freedoms and our shores. All donations are deductible and are greatly appreciated. Each county with a veteran traveling is responsible for raising the cost of \$600.00 to send one veteran. When sending donations, please designate which county your donation is for. There are no states or federal dollars involved, so the success of this program depends on each individual's donation to make this happen. With your help those long deserving veterans will have "their day". Those veterans who have participated in an Honor Flight have termed it as a "trip of a lifetime". A donation of any size is most appreciated.
