The Board of Supervisors of Pocahontas County, Iowa, met in regular session pursuant to adjournment.

Members present: Chairman, Jeffrey Ives; Supervisors, Clarence Siepker, Louis Stauter, and JoAnn Peters; and Auditor, Kelly Jepsen. Supervisor Ed Dewey was present telephonically.

The minutes of July 31, 2018 were approved as presented on motion by Peters, seconded by Dewey. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Siepker, seconded by Stauter, to approve the tentative agenda as presented. Ayes all, motion carried.

Don Etlar, Bolton & Menk Engineer, gave a summary of the proposed tile improvement for DD 64. It was moved by Stauter, seconded by Siepker, to tentatively accept the Engineer's Report for DD 64 and set an informal informational hearing for Tuesday, September 4, 2018 at 1:00 p.m. in the Assembly Room of the Pocahontas County Courthouse. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Stauter, seconded by Siepker, to authorize the Chairman to sign the contract with King Construction for the drainage improvement project on DD 47 Br. F. Ayes all, motion carried.

Brian Larsen, County Sheriff, updated the Board on the accident South of Pocahontas, involving Deputy Wes Van Donge. After discussion, it was moved by Stauter, seconded by Peters, to approve the purchase of a 2019 Ford Explorer in the amount of \$28,910 plus cost for front wiring package and siren package. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Siepker, seconded by Stauter, to approve the hire of Layton Sousa as a full-time dispatcher in the Sheriff's Department. Sousa started August 1, 2018 will be paid \$14.48/hour plus differential as per union contract. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Siepker, seconded by Stauter, to approve payment to Pocahontas County Secondary Roads for Gary Atherton's time on Jt. DD 181 for \$233.68. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Siepker, seconded by Peters, to acknowledge receipt of Manure Management Plans: (1) Christiansen Turkey Site – ID# 64034 located in the SE NE, Sec. 22 Newell Township, BV Co. with Dale Christiansen as owner & contact person; (2) Skog Robert – ID# 57844 located in the NE NE, Sec. 36 Fairfield Township, BV Co. with Bob Skog as owner & contact person; (3) Akridge 1 Site– ID# 65355 located in the SW SW, Sec. 30 West Bend Township, PA Co. with S&L Finishers, LLC as owner and Luke Akridge contact person. Ayes all, motion carried.

Jepsen informed the Board that the State Auditors will be here for two weeks, starting August 13<sup>th</sup> to begin the first half of their annual audit. She also gave an update on upcoming meetings and events.

Jack Moellering, County Engineer, answered questions about different road projects and staffing.
